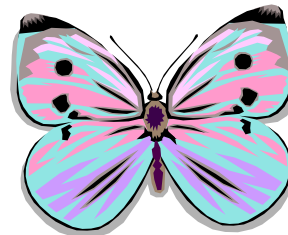

## **Retreat Center Conference & Project Building**



It has been several months since we have had the chance to update you on the progress with the new conference room.

The Diocese has set up a corporation to administer the buildings, the Corpus Christi Catholic Retreat Center, Inc. (CCCRC). Monsignor Richard is the president, and Norman Acker, Matt Hammer, and Melissa Ricard are officers. We have been busy getting organized. The facility has been in place since September, and we think folks are starting to get used to it. By all accounts it has been a great asset to our walks & journeys - better shape to the space, lots of storage and very convenient to the dorm area. We even had an anonymous donor pay to hook up the plumbing and put a coffee bar just inside the door!

Now that the buildings are in place, all we have to do is pay for them. Many people have asked me just exactly how much more we needed to raise, and we have been hesitant to say because everything was happening so fast there for a while, we couldn't keep up with the numbers. Now things have settled down, and we can tell you that the CCCRC still needs to pay back a \$7,000 loan that the Coastal Bend Emmaus Board made out of its operating account. The Emmaus board needs that money back to continue to buy music books, buy and service music equipment and generally run the program. On top of the \$7,000, the facility still needs a few things, and the CCCRC needs a small amount of working capital to get us through the months we have fewer events but still need to pay rent. So, "how much do we need?"- about \$8,000 to \$10,000! So far we have received several very generous donations, and surprisingly few smaller ones. We're not asking you to pay for the whole thing, just help out if you can. Please be in prayer about what the Lord would have you do. Thanks for helping to keep our walks and journeys running smoothly!

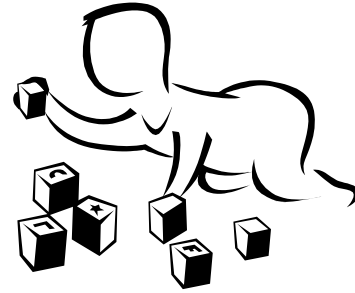
