The very thought of it took me far from my comfort zone. I rattled off several excuses before I committed to the weekend. Thank God, I gave into the pressure. I have never felt the presence of the spirit of Christ as much as when I entered the McConnell unit in Beeville. The closer I came to the "men in white" the more powerful the feeling became. My anxiety about being in a Prison was completely taken away and I have never been so filled with the love of Christ in my life. I have yet to completely understand what God did for me through my Kairos experience. My spiritual journey was deepened beyond my wildest expectations. I have tried to describe it in a nutshell for my brothers and sisters in the Emmaus, Damascus, and Chrysalis community. Simply put, it was the overwhelming feeling of love I feel at every Saturday night candlelight service multiplied by 100 and sustained for 4 days. Simply incredible! I finally realized that if one wants to be close to Christ, one must go to where Christ would go, the prison, yes friends, that is a place you will experience Christ on the faces of the "men in white" like you may have never seen before. I strongly encourage anyone who has given this ministry a thought to do yourself the favor of a lifetime and walk hand in hand with Christ on the next Kairos weekend.
