I hope you like the photo. It sums up my philosophy of faith. The caption reads, "My goal is to do something outrageous every day." I received this photo from my aunt right before I left to go to Uganda on a mission trip. This was a big step of faith for me but God equips those he chooses, right? Anyway, I signed up and then immediately began to have anxiety attacks about being on a plane for so many hours. I would just rather be strapped to the wing, if I had a choice; I'm claustrophobic. For weeks this went on and finally, God was faithful and gave me Matthew 8:26 where Jesus tells his disciples "You of little faith, why are you so afraid." Well, it was a moment for me, kind of a "duh" moment, if you really want to know. God telling me just like the twelve, "how much more do you need to see to believe?" As the days grew closer to our departure, I prayed harder and God continued to reveal his grace to me. Do you know that there are 366 scriptures on fear! One for every day of the year plus one for leap year! I got His message from Scripture, from my own prayer time, from others praying for me, from the book

we were reading in Sunday school, from a poem on my refrigerator, even from cleaning out my purse, and on and on. I began to realize His grace was sufficient and the trip was unbelievable!

Since then I began to see a pattern in my life. Seems God is always calling me into things that are way out of my comfort zone. I would have never guessed that I would be able to serve as the Community Lay Director. You see I've always had a problem with public speaking. I couldn't hold a thought, breathe and speak at the same time! God never revealed His plan to me. He just set the plan in motion. My first team and first talk, my body shook so much I thought my teeth might shatter. But the satisfaction I had from my Father gave me the encouragement to continue on the path before me. Every step of the way was excruciatingly scary. With every job on every team I was pushed to the limit and grew in my faith. Being the Community Lay Director was no different. I knew God would bless my service. All that was required was that I make the first step of faith. He took over after that and oh how I have been grown, and stretched and blessed by serving this community.

Anyway, what I came to learn is this. If I had not agreed to be called to Uganda, or agreed to give a talk or be a Lay Director I would not have been fearful. I was way out of my boat. If I had not been scared of going where I felt called, I would not have reached out to God and received so much. Then I realized that God wants us to wake up each day with this same scenario. What if we woke up every morning and in our minds we tried to imagine the wildest, wildest, scariest thing that God would call us to do that day. We would feel inferior, unequipped and overwhelmed with fear.

We would be driven to His Word, driven to prayer, driven to other Christians for encouragement so that we might see more clearly how God wants to use us. He wants us to get up everyday and say, "OK Lord, what will you have me do today that is OUTRAGEOUS?"

I have no clue what my next assignment will bring. I do know two things; being your Community Lay Director was an experience I will always be grateful for and God's ways are OUTRAGEOUS! He beckons us to get out of our boats so keep your focus on Him and the walking on water will commence.

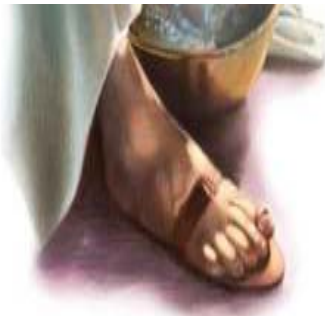
