How is YOUR Fourth Day?



Your time in the cloistered atmosphere of your Emmaus Walk has passed. For some of us it was long ago, but for others much more recent. We have all returned to the world and are now on our "Fourth Day" of that Walk. Have you lost track of some of the enthusiasm you felt during your Walk? I hope all of us are still persevering and walking the Walk. One of the things that is most helpful in our continued journey is to be a member of a Reunion Group. As you probably recall from your Walk, "a Reunion Group is 2 to 6 persons who meet on a regular basis at a regular time for about an hour to support one another in living the Christian ideal of a grace-filled life."

One of the women at my church is in a Reunion Group with people who were pilgrims with her on her Walk ten years ago. She often speaks of the support these women have given each other through those years. The Group I attend is composed of myself (I attended my pilgrim Walk in 1990), one woman who attended her Walk about four years ago, another who attended her Walk in 2011, and our "babe-chick" who attended the Women's Walk last October. This is just to help you see that the Reunion Group does not have a strict formula for members.

To help you find a Reunion Group near you, a list of current groups is listed on the Coastal Bend Emmaus website. It is also easy to form your own Reunion Group. Call someone you know has been on the Walk and invite them to join you in meeting and discussing the questions found in "the order of the meeting" on the reunion card you received on your Walk. If you have any questions about forming or joining a Reunion Group, please call. If I don't have the answer on hand, I will certainly get it for you. I also hope that everyone who has already found a Group is inviting people you know or meet to join your Group.

The group reunion itself is one of the chief values of the Emmaus movement-one of the greatest treasures the Walk to Emmaus contains. It is a way of persevering in the life of grace so that those things that are valuable to you during the weekend will not be lost when you return to the world-the group reunion serves the life of the Emmaus community
