Whew! We did it again! Women's Walk 1579 made !! It was on the verge of being canceled because on Tuesday we only had seven women signed on as Pilgrims. But with the arrival of the mail in San Antonio on Thursday, our last day to make, we reached the acceptable goal of 20 Pilgrims (actually we had 21). Now, thank God, on Oct 7-10 God will touch the hearts and lives of (what I expect to be) a full Walk of 36 Pilgrims who will go back to their churches with a renewed sense of God's call on them to find their special ministry. And, Praise God!, we will have 36 more members of the Coastal Bend Emmaus Community who will become Sponsor's to others.... and so it continues. The greatest gift of agape is the Sponsorship of a former Pilgrim to a Pilgrim to be. All of us who receive this newsletter are "former Pilgrims".

But, ya know, there are some things that we as a community need to do just a "little" bit better. One of those things is to not give anxiety attacks to the teams (Men's Walk 1574 also was a last minute make) who are giving so much of their spirit and time to create the "best Walk ever" wondering if the Walk is going to be canceled two weeks out. We are a bunch of procrastinators! I count myself among us! Now I don't want to paint with too board a brush because I do realize that some seven people got their Pilgrim applications in early and others got them in as soon as they had identified a Pilgrim wanabe. Faith (!), you say, Judi, where is your faith that God will provide. Well, He certainly stretches and exercises my faith when He comes through miraculously. I also know He works through us and sometimes we appear to be a bit slow on the uptake. . But this is the last Walk of 2010 for our 4th day group and it is my personal opinion that the line of potential Pilgrims that God has in mind would fill a hundred Walks.

We have 5 Walks coming up in 2011 Let's begin now to pray about who God leads us to Sponsor for one of the three Women's Walks or two of the Men's Walks next year. And, oh yes, let's make every effort get those applications in early!!!!

Teams give so much to a Walk. They pay their fee, they meet for 24-26 hours to prepare, they make agape, salty and sweet, and pillow agape and they smile and love and care through what can be an exhausting, even though exhilarating, weekend. Teams lately have been asked to give an extra stipend of \$10 or \$20 to purchase sodas, water, extra food agape.

All of us take a bit of ownership of what happens on each and every Walk. All of us are invested. The Board and the Team Selection Committee have asked the Teams to stop requesting that extra stipend and let the community, through Reunion Groups, Churches and individuals begin to share again that bit of burden. Part of our blessing as "community" is the sharing of the ministry of Emmaus. Please, bring out agape to the Walk on Thursday or Friday and come to Candlelight on Sat night, Oct 9 at 8:00 pm. (Babysitting is provided in the Pilgrim dorm for both Candlelight and Closing!) Those Pilgrims on Walk 1579 will light up with love and tears in their eyes when they see your face of love.
